





















# Garbage Disposal Guide

Please put out your garbage by ( ):( )AM on the appropriate day.

Collection times vary depending on the garbage, traffic, etc.  
Different trucks handle different garbage types, so different garbage may be collected at different times even on the same collection day.

Garbage that can be put into Garbage Station (Please do not put more than 10kg of garbage in a single bag, and be sure to tie your bags tightly shut.)

 <p>●Please dispose of burnable garbages in the <b>designated red burnable garbage bags</b>.</p> <p><b>Kitchen Waste/Food Scraps</b></p>  <p><b>Leather</b></p>  <p><b>Plants</b></p>  <p><b>Paper Scraps</b></p>  <p>●Please make sure your kitchen scraps are as dry as possible. ●Please solidify used cooking oil or absorb it with paper, etc. ●Please bend or otherwise take measures to ensure that cooking skewers and other pointy objects can be handled safely.</p>	 <p>● Please dispose of recyclable garbages in the <b>designated yellow recyclable garbage bags</b>.</p> <p><b>Bottles</b></p>  <p><b>Steel/Aluminum Cans</b></p> <p>●Cans, pieces of glass, and metal scraps that exceed 30cm X 30cm are considered <b>non-burnable</b> or <b>bulky</b> garbages. ● Please empty their contents completely and rinse them. Rusted items or items with indelible stains are considered <b>non-burnable</b> garbage. ●Please remove caps from bottles and place metal items in non-burnable garbage bags and plastic items in the designated blue garbage bags. ●Please place the garbage <b>directory</b> in the designated bag without first placing it in other bags, such as plastic grocery bags etc.</p>	 <p>PET bottles are not collected every week.</p> <p>●Please remove caps and labels from the bottles and place only the bottles in the <b>designated pink garbage bag</b>.</p> <p><b>PET Bottle</b></p>  <p>● Please dispose of PET bottle caps and labels in the <b>designated blue garbage bags</b>. Please note that paper labels are <b>burnable garbage</b>.</p> <p>●Please completely empty the contents and rinse. ※Bottles with indelible stains are considered <b>burnable garbage</b>. ●Please dispose of PET bottles without cutting them. ● Please place the garbage <b>directory</b> in the designated bag without first placing it in other bags, such as plastic grocery bags etc.</p>	 <p>Please place plastic containers and/or packaging used to contain products in the <b>designated blue garbage bags</b> when disposing of them.</p> <p><b>Bottles</b> (food, daily necessities, beverages, etc.)</p>  <p><b>Trays</b> (including styrofoam)</p>  <p><b>Cups</b> (including styrofoam)</p>  <p><b>Cushioning Materials</b> (fruit nets, air caps, plastic confectionery box partitions, styrofoam)</p>  <p><b>Cases</b> (eggs, tofu, box lunches, prepared food packages)</p>  <p><b>Bags</b> (confectionery bags, grocery bags, plastic bags)</p>  <p><b>Other</b> (caps, labels, etc from plastic bottles)</p>  <p>●Please completely empty the contents and rinse. ※Bottles with indelible stains are considered <b>burnable garbage</b>. ●Please products such as toys, stationary and miscellaneous goods are considered <b>non-burnable</b> or <b>bulky</b> garbages. ● Please place the garbage <b>directory</b> in the designated bag without first placing it in other bags, such as plastic grocery bags etc.</p>	<p>●Do <b>not</b> bind newspapers and magazines with string.</p> <p><b>Newspaper</b> (including folded files)</p>  <p><b>magazines / leaflets / catalogs / wrapping paper / copy paper etc.</b></p>  <p>●Please make sure to <b>fold it flat fist</b>. ●When binding cardboard, please bind in a cross shape with a string, and put the bundle out for collection without putting it into a plastic bag. ●Please fold large cardboard to a length of 1 meter or less. ●When binding, please make sure that the number of cardboard boxes per bundle is 10 or less.</p> <p>●Please put newspaper and Magazines in <b>separate Transparent / translucent bags</b>. Also, please use bags <b>45 liters in size or less</b>.</p> <p>●There is no garbage disposal <b>free</b>. ●Finally torn or dirty newspaper, magazines, and cardboard are considered <b>burnable garbage</b>. ●If possible, please refrain from putting out paper garbage on rainy days and wait for the next collection day.</p>	<p><b>Cardboard</b></p>  <p>●Please make sure to <b>fold it flat fist</b>. ●When binding cardboard, please bind in a cross shape with a string, and put the bundle out for collection without putting it into a plastic bag. ●Please fold large cardboard to a length of 1 meter or less. ●When binding, please make sure that the number of cardboard boxes per bundle is 10 or less.</p>	
<p><b>Precautions for using garbage stations !</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>●Keep the <b>day of the week</b> and <b>time</b>.</li> <li>●<b>Separate</b> the garbage properly.</li> <li>●Take the garbage out to a <b>decided garbage station</b>. The garbage station is maintained and managed by users in each region. ※Garbage stations where garbage can be put out are decided for each place where you live.</li> <li>●<b>Don't scatter</b> garbage.</li> <li>●If a violation sticker is affixed to the garbage, take it home, separate it properly, and put it out.</li> </ul>
